MONDAY **8-8-11**

WEDNESDAY **8-10-11**

The Refrain: God has called me

Prayer: God, you have called to me in spite of my past and my weaknesses. What do you want me to give up? What is holding me back from following you?

THURSDAY **8-11-11**

The Refrain: I have sinned against God. God has forgiven me.

Prayer: Keep me, O God, from spiritual blindness. Shine a light on the dark places. Point out my sin. Help me to live in step with the ways of Jesus.

FRIDAY **8-12-11**

The Refrain: I will tell others about what God has done for me.

Prayer: God, sometimes I am wild and reckless. Sometimes I am possessed by fear and anger. But you can restore me to right living. Renew my mind and my heart so that I can follow you completely
