WEDNESDAY 11-16-11

The Refrain: I won't be afraid to use what God has given me.

Prayer: God, you have given me so much. You have invested in me and you expect me to use what I have been given. Give me the courage to do what you have called me to do.

THURSDAY 11-17-11
