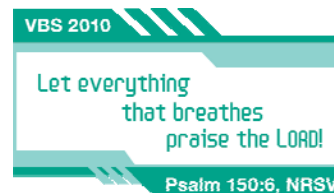

God's Creation

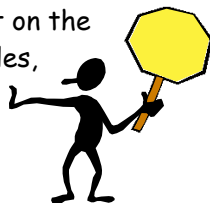
Kids, come join us during the 9:30 hour and explore God's creations both in and out doors.
