Foundational Scripture:

Colossians 3:15-17

Featured Scripture Reflection

“And sing, sing your hearts out to God! Let every detail in your lives—words, actions, whatever—be done in the name of the Master, Jesus, thanking God the Father every step of the way.”

Opening Icebreaker

What are you thankful for today?

Scripture Questions

What is the scripture saying?

- What does it mean to be “... in tune with each other, in step with each other.” and how is this different from “doing your own thing”?
- Why do you think Paul encourages the church at Colosse to sing their hearts out to God in the context of this scripture?

How is your life touched?

- How does being grateful make a difference in your everyday life?
- What would it take to allow God's Word to have the run of your dwelling place?
- Consider one area of your life where you have not been grateful. What would it look like if you could be grateful there?

What is God's invitation to you?

- Jesus invites you to take your attention off of yourself and become familiar with a dwelling place of gratitude. In this space it is possible to be thankful regardless of the circumstances in which you find yourself. God offers you the power to overcome through the context of gratitude.

What can you pray for?

- Pray that the Chilson Hills community would be filled with gratitude to God and one another through good times, and especially through challenges that we might become free of the control of our circumstances and more like Christ.
