## **Scripture Questions**

*What is the scripture saying?*

- Given the Corinthians’ quest for spiritual power, what is the Apostle Paul’s point in verses 1-3?
- What is “Love” not?
- What is “Love” as described in this chapter.
- What is the significance of verse 13?

*How is your life touched?*

- What is the easiest part of the Bible’s definition of love for you to keep?
- What is the hardest part of the Bible’s definition of love to actually live out?
- What are ways you can practice Christ-like love within the circle of your family?
- What are ways you can practice Christ-like love with your friends?
- What are ways you can practice Christ-like love with strangers you meet every day?

*What is God’s invitation to you?*

- Jesus challenges you to make a difference each day you are alive on this planet. The power for making a difference is Christ-like love. Talk with your Lifegroup about ways they can pray for you to grow in Christ-like love.
