*Consider the following sermon-based questions for your individual study or with a group of folks like one of the several Life Groups available at Chilson Hills.*

## **Foundational Scripture:**

*Luke 13:31-35*

## **Featured Scripture Reflection**

*“Jesus said, ‘Tell that fox (King Herod) that I’ve no time for him right now. Today and tomorrow I’m busy clearing out the demons and healing the sick; the third day I’m wrapping things up.’” (Luke 13:32-34, The Message)*

## **Opening Icebreaker**

*What place do you identify with your spiritual roots?*

## **Scripture Questions**

*What is the scripture saying?*

- What does Jesus reveal about his mission on earth?
- How does Jesus’ statement here relate to his earlier statement in Nazareth about his mission? (Luke 4: 14-30)
- What does Jesus’ response to the religious leaders indicate about his view of politics?
- What is Jesus saying about the importance of actually choosing what you will do and what you will be concerned about?

*How is your life touched?*

- What concerns you about the state of the Church in this time?
- What do you think Jesus would say to the politicians who use religion to get ahead?
- What does Jesus mean when he refers to himself as a ‘mother hen’? Can Jesus also be talking about his relationship with you?
- When is a time you have felt that God gathered you under her wing and comforted and protected you?

*What is God’s invitation to you?*

- Jesus challenges you to step outside your normal box and see the world from a different perspective. You are a Citizen of God’s Kingdom! What difference does that reality make for you this week?

*What can you pray for?*

- Pray that Chilson Hills will be a joyous Community of God’s incredible love power celebrating Jesus Christ and Jesus’ invitation to be a citizen of the Kingdom of God.
