

Life Application Questions

Consider the following sermon-based questions for your individual study or with a group of folks like one of the several Life Groups available at Chilson Hills.

Foundational Scripture

Revelation 7:9-17

Featured Scripture Reflection

“These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the lamb.” (Revelation 7:14b, NIV)

Opening Icebreaker

What piece of clothing really expresses your personality? How do you feel when you wear it?

Scripture Questions

What is the scripture saying?

- How does John describe the crowd gathered around the throne of God?
- What do you think is the significance of the people wearing white robes?
- How do the angels respond to the shouts of the crowd?
- What does this vision say about the nature of God and of Christ’s life, death, and resurrection?
- What is Jesus’ promise for the white-robed people gathered around the throne?

How is your life touched?

- What do you need to do to be able to wear one of God’s white robes?
- What is the greatest tribulation (persecution) facing you?
- What can help you to praise God in the manner that those wearing white robes are praising God?
- When you think of “heavenly worship of God,” what vision comes into your mind?

What is God’s invitation to you?

- The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world is the Savior of the world. What can you do this week to grow more like Christ and less like this world? In other words, what do you need to do to get your robe a little cleaner?

What can you pray for?

- Pray that Chilson Hills will be a joyous Community of God’s incredible resurrection power celebrating Jesus Christ’s transforming hope and love in our lives and in our community.
