Reflection

Icebreaker:

If you are occasionally, “not feeling too good yourself,” with life, how are you “feeling’ alright” with Christ?”

What’s Going On in the Scripture Stories

- In Mark’s Gospel story, what is the big deal of Bartemeaus leaving his cloak behind on the ground when he jumps up to greet Jesus?
- What’s the most important to Bartemeaus for life? What make him feel alright?
- Check out the description of Jesus in Hebrews. Do you know Jesus like this?
