Foundational Scripture:

Mark 13:1-8

Featured Scripture Reflection

Opening Icebreaker

What are the two things you would want to take to heaven if you could?

Scripture Questions

What is the scripture saying?

- What significance is there that Jesus uses his discussion of the temple to begin his teaching about the ‘Day of the Lord’?
- What would the destruction of the temple do to the people of Israel?
- What can Jesus mean when he warns the disciples to beware of people who will deceive?
- What comfort does Jesus offer his disciples in the midst of this teaching on the end of the world?

How is your life touched?

- When you see the forces of evil winning, what is your response?
- How can you keep from being deceived?
- What is the most exciting thing about the Second Coming of Christ for you?
- What is the most disturbing about Christ returning to earth?

What is God’s invitation to you?

- Jesus warns you to stay on watch, to be prepared, and to not be deceived. What are ways your Lifegroup can help you this week to follow Jesus’ instructions?

What can you pray for?

- Pray that Chilson Hills will be a community of God’s people who are committed to living God’s abundant life right here and right now because we are prepared to share eternity with Christ at any moment.
