Consider the following sermon-based questions for your individual study or with a group of folks like one of the several Life Groups available at Chilson Hills.

Foundational Scripture:

Genesis 1:1-10

Featured Scripture Reflection

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” (Genesis 1:1, NIV)

Opening Icebreaker

If you could create a new animal, what would it look like? What would its name be? What would be its most important feature?

Scripture Questions

What is the scripture saying?

- What does this passage tell you about God using chaos?
- What is the meaning of God’s spoken words in the context of God’s creative power?
- What does John 1:1-3 add to “Genesis understanding” of God’s creation?
- What does the emphasis of Mark 1:10-11 tell you about the nature of our Creator God?

How is your life touched?

- How aware are you of God’s creative world in your everyday life?
- What does “God’s bringing order out of chaos” have to do with your life today?
- What does it mean to you to be created in the image of God? How does that relate to your close relationships?
- How does Genesis 1 help you understand the concept of God as a Triune God?

What is God’s invitation to you?

- God is awesome, mysterious, and beyond comprehension, yet God is also accessible to you through Jesus Christ. Ponder this week the majesty and wonder of God. Decide on specific ways you are going to trust God this week!

What can you pray for?

Pray that Chilson Hills will be people love our Triune God even though we cannot fully understand what that phrase means.
